Parents allowed to be let through the gate at pick up and drop off	This is now in place.
More information about the Kingswood trip	An information meeting date has been set for Tuesday 12 <sup>th</sup> March at 4.30pm.
Support for children who need extra help and parents	The next parent café will be on 5.3.24 starting 9am. Mel Perry from the North Norfolk Help Hub will join us for coffee, along with Mrs Parkinson our school parent support adviser. This café is for all parents to come and chat in general and not just those needing help.
Regular parent meetings to discuss concerns, ideas, etc	We aim to hold a parent café every half term, we will try to hold some at the end of the day instead of the morning.
PTA/more fundraising	After talking to parents, it was felt that rather than people committing to a PTA, we could plan events and then ask for a list of volunteers who would be able to help. More information will come out to you shortly via Class Dojo about the first event.
Cycling proficiency	This is now called Bikeability and is for Y5 and Y6 children. Sadly, they are completely booked up for this academic year but we have managed to secure a booking for next year. The date is March 2025 and we will send more information nearer the time.
Birch class support around changes in teacher	Mrs Pugh will be working in Birch on Mondays, Tuesdays and Wednesdays after February half term. This will be until the summer or earlier if we are able to appoint a permanent replacement for Mr Cullen before then. She will be spending some time in school on the last week of this half term to get to know the children. The children will still have Mrs Riseborough, Mrs Rockley and Miss Way in the class. Adults will check in with the children regularly and can address any concerns the children may have.
More swimming lessons	These have been booked for the summer term. Y3/4 will have swimming lessons during the first summer half term every Friday afternoon. Y5/6 will swim in the second summer half term every Wednesday afternoon.
